

CISRS - Scaffolding Awareness..

Course Introduction

This 1-day Scaffolding Awareness course has been introduced to provide those who use scaffolding as part of their work, or site management personnel who have responsibilities for scaffolding operations.

This course will provide delegates with greater understanding and appreciation of the potential dangers that may occur when working at height. This course will also help delegates identify the core components of safe scaffold.

Upon completion of the 1 Day Scaffolding Awareness, delegates will gain an insight into scaffold best practice and what they should expect from their scaffold contractor. It is important to understand and be aware that this course will NOT provide delegates with the knowledge relating to scaffold inspection.
